What is Career Day?

Every spring, Environmental Charter Middle School - Inglewood (ECMS-I) hosts our annual Career Day. The purpose of this event is to give students direct exposure to inspiring professionals and leaders, create an opportunity for speakers to share about their path to success and allow students to ask questions.
